11:00 am – 12:00 pm	Specialized Caseloads for Domestic Violence Offenders in Community Corrections <i>Alexis Ongley, Assistant Director Community Corrections</i> Larimer County Community Corrections has created a specialized case management model that uses knowledge, research, and collaboration to effectively supervise Domestic Violence offenders in the community. Training for case management, as well as security staff, is emphasized to effectively identify, recognize, and address Domestic Violence and abusive behaviors. The primary goals are to change behavior utilizing treatment and the collaboration of the Multidisciplinary Team (MTT), to protect current and potential victims, and address all abusive behaviors. The use of Terms and Conditions allows the case manager and offender to focus and discuss treatment expectations and the protections of past victims and new potential victims as well as the expectation of remaining free of all forms of Domestic Violence.
